## ROAD OPEN: 1 WEEK TO GO!

**The final touches are being undertaken as this, seemingly mammoth, scheme draws to a close.** We have now removed the scaffolding at Monkton Combe and are currently tidying the area beneath the wall in anticipation of scheme completion. The first picture below shows the state of the original retaining wall and the second picture shows what the completed wall now looks like.



At Limpley Stoke the safety barrier is being erected on top of the capping beam and we have installed new posts at the roadside to house signs. While there has been significantly less traffic using the A36 we have also been clearing vegetation and grass cutting where possible. Next week we will be resurfacing the full carriageway width from Waterhouse Lane to the B3108 traffic signals.

In co-operation with the Highways Agency, Limpley Stoke Parish Council and Limpley Stoke Events Committee are organising a small celebration to mark the re-opening of the A36. This will take place on the viaduct between 18:00 and 20:00 on Friday 20th June. Monkton Combe School's Big Band has kindly agreed to provide some live music and a fun tug-of-war, in the fields under the bridge, will be arranged on the night. Residents are encouraged to walk/cycle, although some limited car parking will be available. The road is scheduled to be re-opened at 21:00 when all traffic management has been removed.

## Resurfacing from Church Lane to Farleigh Service Station

Please be reminded that we will be carrying out a large section of resurfacing on the A36, between Church Lane and Farleigh Service Station over the weekend. Work commenced overnight on Thursday 12th June and is due to be completed on Sunday 15th June. During the work there will be a significant difference in the level of the road, so please take extra care when driving through this section and follow the instructions of our staff to ensure safe passage through the works. Route stewards will be in position around the local road network to advise drivers which section of road is being worked on and the most appropriate route to take. These will be in radio contact with the resurfacing crews and will be easily identified by bright yellow jackets and trousers.
